Proposed program for Saturday 3rd June 2023

The Mt Clarence Hillclimb track will be open at 7:30am, practice is scheduled to start at 9:00am. A compulsory Drivers' Briefing before the commencement of practice runs will be held in the assembly area 15 mins before each group runs. All vehicles complying with the 2023 VSCC Standing Regulations will be eligible for entry.

Proposed Program for Sunday 4th June 2023

The Albany Classic will be held on the street circuit in the Albany townsite. A compulsory drivers' briefing will be held at 8.15am in the pits/assembly area, behind the library building. Practice is scheduled to start at 9:45am with the competition events scheduled to start at 11:10am.

The regularity events will be conducted for vehicles complying with the regulations for 5th Category Historic Cars Groups A, C, F, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, as outlined in the current Motorsport Australia Manual of Motorsport.

Scrutineering/Scrutiny

All Competitors will be required to complete the Motorsport Australia "Self-Scrutiny Checklist", "Self-Scrutiny Declaration" and forward all with the entry form to entries@vsccwa.com.au or VSCCWA Entries, PO Box 7277 Spearwood WA 6163. Entries without the completed Declaration and Checklist WILLNOT be accepted.

ALL entrants of regularity vehicles **MUST** present their vehicle for scrutiny. In addition, you helmet and apparel, in compliance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual, be presented for inspection. Your Motorsport Australia Licence, Club membership and logbook (Motorsport Australia or otherwise) is to be produced at scrutiny and on request during the meeting. If using a "Frontal Head Restraint (FHR)" a 6-point harness is mandatory and will be checked at scrutineering.

Scrutiny Location

Scrutiny for Regularity Competitors will be held on Saturday 20th May between 8:00am and 11:00am at the VSCCWA Caversham Clubrooms off Harrow Road Caversham.

ALL METRO COMPETITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND OR A \$50 FEE WILL BE CHARGED IF YOU ARE SCRUTINEERED ON THE DAY.
