You don't need to own a car to be a member of our club – you just need to be interested in historic motor sport.

Here are some of the events that we usually run each year:

- Round-the-Houses Regularity at Albany & Northam (Motorsport Australia Category 5 Events)
- Sprints and Regularity at Wanneroo Raceway & Collie Motor Sport Park (Open Events)
- Hill-climbs at Wanneroo, Collie, Albany and Northam. (Open Events)
- Social events and (open to all)
- “Dad’s Army” workshop sessions twice each month at Caversham (similar to a Men’s Shed)

Vehicle Eligibility

Round-the-Houses regularity events (Albany & Northam) are generally limited to vehicles in Motorsport Australia’s Category 5 (see below). However, we occasionally accept vehicles which have some interesting history or are a car of special interest.

Here is a quick run-down on Motorsport Australia’s Category 5 classes:

- Groups J, K, & L - generally cars which could have been in competition on race tracks between 1900 & 1960 (remembering other similar cars are sometimes invited into events for this group)
- Groups M, O, P, Q & R - generally open-wheel racing cars built between 1950 & 1980 (again, other similar cars of special interest are sometimes invited to run in this group)
- Group S - mainly sports cars between built 1960 & 1980 (again other similar cars of special interest are sometimes invited to run in this group)
- Group N - sedans which we generally place into 2 groupings:
 - the smaller capacity 4-cylinder sedans built between 1950 & 1980
 - 6- & 8-cylinder sedans built between 1950 & 1980
 - sometimes similar cars and cars of interest join these groups.

All other events are open to entries from all types of vehicles, as long as they meet Motorsport Australia’s general safety requirements.

Come and help out – no obligation.

We always welcome volunteers to keep the club running or help run competition events.

We have regular “Dad’s Army” workshops twice a month at our clubhouse at Caversham.

We also need flag marshals, track builders and other officials at competition events.

All you need is to be interested in historic motor sport and want to be with like-minded people!
